

HOW DO I PRAY THE PRO-LIFE ROSARY OF THE UNBORN™?

“This is My Crown of Victory. See and understand that this Rosary of the Unborn is an integral part of My Victory, both in hearts and in the world.”
(Mary, Refuge of Holy Love – March 18, 2002)



Our Lady gives the World the Rosary of the Unborn

On October 7, 1997– the Feast of the Holy Rosary – Our Lady appeared to the American Visionary, Maureen Sweeney-Kyle, with this rosary and stated: **“Propagate the image I have shown you today.”**

October 7, 1997 – Feast of the Holy Rosary

Our Lady comes in white. In front of Her and suspended in the air is an unusual Rosary. The Our Father beads are droplets of blood in the shape of a cross. The Hail Mary beads are light blue teardrops with unborn babies inside of them. The cross is gleaming gold. Our Lady says: “I come in praise of Jesus, My Son. I come as Prophetess of these times.”

“The Rosary you see is Heaven’s way of describing to you the weapon that will overcome this evil of abortion. Heaven weeps for the cost of this great sin. The history and the future of all nations has been changed because of this atrocity against God’s gift of life.”

“Today, sadly, much responsibility must be placed on the laity who are consecrated to Me. I cannot depend on Church leadership to unite in an effort to vanquish the enemy through the Rosary. Even My apparitions have caused division by Satan’s efforts to thwart My plans.”

“So today, on My feast day, I am calling all My children to unite in My Heart. Do not allow pride to divide you according to which apparition you will follow. Become part of the Flame of My Heart. Be united in love and in the prayer weapon of My Rosary. The evil of abortion can be conquered by your efforts and through My grace.”

“Propagate the image I have shown you today.”

Heaven’s Promises for using this Rosary to pray against Abortion

1. Each Hail Mary

Blessed Mother: “I affirm to you, my daughter, that **each ‘Hail Mary’ prayed from a loving heart will rescue one of these innocent lives from death by abortion.** When you use this Rosary, call to mind My Sorrowful Immaculate Heart which continually sees the sin of abortion played out in every present moment. I give to you this special sacramental* with which to heal My Motherly Heart.”

Maureen asks: “Blessed Mother, do you mean any ‘Hail Mary’ or just one prayed on the Rosary of the Unborn?”

Blessed Mother: “This is a special grace attached to this particular Rosary. It should always be used to pray against abortion. You will please make this known.” (*Our Lady as the Sorrowful Mother – July 2, 2001 Afternoon*)

(***Note:** In order to be a sacramental, the Rosary must be blessed by a Catholic Priest.)

2. Each Our Father

Jesus: “Please tell the world that **each ‘Our Father’ recited on the Rosary of the Unborn assuages My grieving Heart. Further, it withholds the Arm of Justice.**” (*Jesus – August 3, 2001*)

3. A Complete Rosary (A 5-decade Rosary)

Jesus: “The greatest promise I give you in regards to this Rosary is this: Every (5-decade) Rosary prayed from the heart to its completion on these beads **mitigates the punishment as yet withstanding for the sin of abortion...** When I say the punishment as yet withstanding for the sin of abortion, I mean **the punishment each soul deserves for taking part in this sin.** Then too, I also refer to **the greater punishment that awaits the world for embracing this sin.** Pray from your heart knowing that your Rosary appeases Me.” (*Jesus – August 3, 2001*)

4. Group Prayer

Jesus: “If a group is gathered who are praying for the unborn from the heart and only one person has in their possession the Rosary of the Unborn, **I will honor each ‘Hail Mary’ from each person in the group as if they were holding the Rosary of the Unborn themselves.** In this way I lift the constraint of time which it takes to produce enough rosaries.” (*Jesus – February 28, 2005*)

PRAYING THE PRO-LIFE ROSARY OF THE UNBORN

When we use the Rosary of the Unborn to pray against abortion, we are asked by Heaven to:

1. Pray from the heart.

“When you are asked to pray from the heart, you must pray with Holy Love in your heart.” (St. Thomas Aquinas – November 2, 2002)

“You are in My Heart when you pray from the heart.” (Our Lady – June 14, 1994)

“When you pray from the heart, your prayers rise as Veronica's veil to wipe the tears from My Face as I cast My gaze upon this generation.” (Jesus – February 7, 2002)

“Pray from your heart knowing that your Rosary appeases me.” (Jesus – August 3, 2001)

“Satan does not want you to realize the power of this Rosary when you pray from the heart. I am telling you, that the Rosary of the Unborn saves lives!” (Jesus – October 8, 2007)

2. Call to mind Our Lady's Sorrowful Immaculate Heart.

“When you use this Rosary, call to mind My Sorrowful Immaculate Heart which continually sees the sin of abortion played out in every present moment.” (The Sorrowful Mother – July 2, 2001)

3. Pray that hearts are convicted in the Truth about abortion.

“When you pray the Rosary of the Unborn, pray that hearts are convicted in the Truth. It is only when the spirit of the world reflects the light of Truth that victory will come.” (St. Thomas Aquinas – October 7, 2007)

PRAYERS OF THE PRO-LIFE ROSARY OF THE UNBORN

Note: At Our Lady's request, we pray the 'Glory Be' as '**All Glory Be...**' (Our Lady of Guadalupe – September 21, 1995) and we also pray '**Jesus, protect and save the unborn**' after each decade of the Rosary (Mary, Refuge of Holy Love – May 19, 1998).

1. OPENING PRAYERS

(Begin by stating the intention:)

I/We offer this Rosary for the end to abortion and that hearts are convicted in the Truth about abortion.

(Then raise your rosary to Heaven and say:)

Celestial Queen, with this Rosary, I bind all sinners and all nations to Your Immaculate Heart.
(Our Lady – October 7, 1996)

The Sign of the Cross

In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Prayer for the Conversion of Hearts

Heavenly Father, during this time of world crisis, let all souls find their peace and security in Your Divine Will. Give each soul the grace to understand that Your Will is Holy Love in the present moment.

Benevolent Father, illuminate each conscience to see the ways that he is not living in Your Will. Grant the world the grace to change and the time in which to do it. Amen.

(Dictated by Mary, the Mother of God, on September 28, 2001, after the 9/11 terrorist attack on the United States)

Prayer to Recite with the Rosary of the Unborn

Divine Infant Jesus, as we pray this Rosary, we ask You to remove from the heart of the world the desire to commit the sin of abortion. Remove the veil of deceit Satan has placed over hearts which portrays promiscuity as a freedom, and reveal it for what it is – slavery to sin.

Place over the heart of the world a renewed respect for life at the moment of conception. Amen.

(Our Lady – August 27, 2005)

The Apostles' Creed

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of Heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son Our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into Hell; the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into Heaven, and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty; from thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen.

Our Father

(For the intentions of the Holy Father)

Our Father, who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy Name. Thy Kingdom come. Thy Will be done on earth, as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Hail Mary

(Pray three Hail Mary's for an increase of the virtues of Faith, Hope and Charity)

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

All Glory Be

All Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

(Our Lady of Guadalupe – September 21, 1995)

Fatima Prayer

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to heaven, especially those in most need of Thy Mercy.

Prayer for the Unborn

Jesus, protect and save the unborn.
(Mary, Refuge of Holy Love – May 19, 1998)

2. THE MYSTERIES OF THE ROSARY

The Rosary consists of twenty (20) decades divided into four (4) sets of Mysteries (*Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful, and Glorious*) depicting events in the lives of Jesus and Mary in chronological order. Each set of Mysteries consists of five (5) decades, with each decade recalling a particular Mystery or event. The Rosary can be prayed in full by praying all four sets of Mysteries (all 20 decades) at one time or in part by praying one set of Mysteries (a 5-decade Rosary). When the Rosary is prayed as a 5-decade Rosary, it is considered a complete Rosary.

When praying the *Pro-Life Rosary of the Unborn*, we recommend using the *Pro-Life Rosary Intentions* dictated by Our Lady on June 4, 2011, as stated below. (*"My Motherly Heart is intercessor for these needs, My children, when you pray from the heart. I am ever ready to assist you. Pray this way often."* Our Lady – June 4, 2011)

We also recommend the *Pro-Life Meditations on the Mysteries of the Rosary* by Priests for Life, which are included below* and which can be found on their website (<https://www.priestsforlife.org>).

PRAYERS TO RECITE DURING EACH DECADE

For each decade of the Rosary, we recite the following prayers after the Meditation:

Our Father... Ten (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... Fatima Prayer... Prayer for the Unborn

The Joyful Mysteries *(Prayed on Monday and Saturday)*

FIRST JOYFUL MYSTERY: The Annunciation

Intention: *"We seek Blessed Mother's protection over the unborn."*

Meditation: Mary is troubled by the angel's greeting, yet rejoices to do God's will. Let us pray that those who are troubled by their pregnancy may have the grace to trust in God's will.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

SECOND JOYFUL MYSTERY: The Visitation

Intention: *"We pray for guidance for all involved in the abortion industry and mothers considering abortion."*

Meditation: John the Baptist leapt for joy in his mother's womb. We pray that people may realize that abortion is not about children who "might" come into the world, but is about children who are already in the world, living and growing in the womb, and are scheduled to be killed.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

THIRD JOYFUL MYSTERY: The Nativity

Intention: *"We pray for the conversion of anyone who supports abortion."*

Meditation: God himself was born as a child. The greatness of a person does not depend on size, for the newborn King is very small. Let us pray for an end to prejudice against the tiny babies threatened by abortion.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

FOURTH JOYFUL MYSTERY: The Presentation

Intention: *"We pray for government leaders who support abortion."*

Meditation: The Child is presented in the Temple because the Child belongs to God. Children are not the property of their parents, nor of the government. They – and we – belong to God Himself.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

FIFTH JOYFUL MYSTERY: The Finding of the Child Jesus in the Temple

Intention: *"We pray for any religious leader who does not speak out against abortion."*

Meditation: The boy Jesus was filled with wisdom, because He is God. Let us pray that all people may see the wisdom of His teachings about the dignity of life, and may understand that this teaching is not an opinion, but the truth.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

The Luminous Mysteries *(Prayed on Thursday)*

FIRST LUMINOUS MYSTERY: Christ is baptized in the Jordan

Intention: *"We seek Blessed Mother's protection over the unborn."*

Meditation: When Jesus is baptized, the Father's voice is heard: *"This is my beloved Son."* All are called to become adopted sons and daughters of God through baptism. We pray that children in the womb may be protected, so that they may be born and welcomed into the Christian community by baptism.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

SECOND LUMINOUS MYSTERY: The Wedding at Cana

Intention: *"We pray for guidance for all involved in the abortion industry and mothers considering abortion."*

Meditation: Jesus revealed His glory by the miracle at Cana. The new couple was blessed not only with wine, but with faith in Christ. Let us pray for strong marriages, rooted in the Lord, and open to the gift of new life.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

THIRD LUMINOUS MYSTERY: Christ proclaims the Kingdom of God and calls All to Conversion

Intention: *"We pray for the conversion of anyone who supports abortion."*

Meditation: *"Repent and believe the Good News."* Let us pray that these first words of Jesus' public ministry may be heard by all who have committed abortion. May they know that the Lord calls them to conversion, and may they experience life-giving repentance.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

FOURTH LUMINOUS MYSTERY: The Transfiguration

Intention: *"We pray for government leaders who support abortion."*

Meditation: Christ is transformed on the mountain, and the disciples see His glory. May the eyes of all people be transformed, that they may see each and every human life as a reflection of the glory of God Himself.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

FIFTH LUMINOUS MYSTERY: Jesus gives us the Eucharist

Intention: *"We pray for any religious leader who does not speak out against abortion."*

Meditation: *"This is My Body, given up for you."* The Eucharist teaches us how to live and how to love. Let us pray that parents who sacrifice the babies for the sake of themselves may learn instead to put themselves aside for the sake of their babies.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

The Sorrowful Mysteries

(Prayed on Tuesday and Friday)

FIRST SORROWFUL MYSTERY: The Agony in the Garden

Intention: *"We seek Blessed Mother's protection over the unborn."*

Meditation: Let us pray for mothers and fathers who are in agony because they are tempted to abort a child. May they be given the good news that there are alternatives, and may they make use of the help that is available.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

SECOND SORROWFUL MYSTERY: The Scourging at the Pillar

Intention: *"We pray for guidance for all involved in the abortion industry and mothers considering abortion."*

Meditation: As Christ's flesh was torn by the instruments of those who scourged Him, so the bodies of babies in the womb are torn by the instruments of the abortionists. Let us pray that abortionists may repent of these acts of child-killing.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

THIRD SORROWFUL MYSTERY: The Crowning with Thorns

Intention: *"We pray for the conversion of anyone who supports abortion."*

Meditation: Jesus suffered the pain of thorns in His head, and did so silently. We pray for the mothers and fathers of aborted children. So many of them suffer deep grief and regret over a choice they can never reverse. So many suffer in silence, because others tell them it's no big deal.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

FOURTH SORROWFUL MYSTERY: The Carrying of the Cross

Intention: *"We pray for government leaders who support abortion."*

Meditation: Jesus was not condemned by the power of wicked people. He was condemned because of the silence of good people. Silence always helps the oppressor, never the victim. Let us pray that we may never be silent about abortion, but rather will clearly speak up to save babies from death.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

FIFTH SORROWFUL MYSTERY: The Crucifixion

Intention: *"We pray for any religious leader who does not speak out against abortion."*

Meditation: As we ponder the death of Christ, let us remember the many women who have died from so-called "safe, legal" abortions. Let us ask forgiveness and mercy for them. May their memory save other women from making this tragic mistake.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

The Glorious Mysteries

(Prayed on Wednesday and Sunday)

FIRST GLORIOUS MYSTERY: The Resurrection

Intention: *"We seek Blessed Mother's protection over the unborn."*

Meditation: Christ is Risen! By his Resurrection, He has destroyed the power of death, and therefore the power of abortion. The outcome of the battle for Life has already been decided: Life is victorious! Let us pray that all pro-lifers will spread this victory to every segment of our society.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

SECOND GLORIOUS MYSTERY: The Ascension

Intention: *"We pray for guidance for all involved in the abortion industry and mothers considering abortion."*

Meditation: By ascending to the Father's throne, Christ takes our human nature, given to us in the womb, to the heights of heaven. He shows us that human beings are made to be raised to heaven, not thrown in the garbage. Let us pray that the world may learn this truth and reject abortion.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

THIRD GLORIOUS MYSTERY: The Descent of the Holy Spirit

Intention: *"We pray for the conversion of anyone who supports abortion."*

Meditation: The Holy Spirit is the Advocate: He pleads our cause, for we cannot save ourselves. We pray that He will make us advocates for the babies, who cannot speak or write or vote or protest or even pray.

Prayers: *Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.*

FOURTH GLORIOUS MYSTERY: The Assumption

Intention: "We pray for government leaders who support abortion."

Meditation: The Blessed Virgin Mary was taken body and soul into heaven because she is the Mother of God. Mother and child are united. The Assumption reminds us that they belong together. We pray that society will see that it cannot love women while killing their children, and cannot save children without helping their mothers. We pray that people will be touched by the pro-life question, "Why can't we love them both?"

Prayers: Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.

FIFTH GLORIOUS MYSTERY: The Coronation

Intention: "We pray for any religious leader who does not speak out against abortion."

Meditation: Mary is the Queen of the Universe. The Church teaches that she is the greatest creature, second only to God Himself. The Church defends the dignity of women. We pray that people will understand that to be pro-life means to be pro-woman, and that to be pro-woman demands that we be pro-life.

Prayers: Our Father... (10) Hail Mary's... All Glory Be... O my Jesus ... Jesus, protect and save the unborn.

3. CLOSING PRAYERS (Optional prayers may be added.)

Hail, Holy Queen

Hail, Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy! Our life, our sweetness and our hope! To Thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve; to Thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn, then, most Gracious Advocate, Thine Eyes of mercy toward us, and after this our exile, show unto us the blessed Fruit of Thy Womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.

V. Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God.

R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray. O God, whose only begotten Son, by His life, death and resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech Thee, that meditating upon these Mysteries of the Most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain, and obtain what they promise through the same Christ, Our Lord. Amen.

(For the intentions and well-being of the Holy Father)

Our Father... Hail Mary... All Glory Be...

St. Joseph Prayer
